- Glazed Expressions entries have issue and page numbers only.
- Journal entries are indicated by 'J' followed by page numbers.
- Buildings are entered under towns (British) or national headings (buildings abroad). Churches, Houses, etc are also entered under a generic heading.
- Book Reviews are entered by author under the heading 'Book Reviews' and by topic e.g. Public houses.
- Living people are entered in *italics*.
- Information on individuals is given in brackets where possible
- Names of British manufacturers are entered independently, but: foreign manufacturers are entered under the country of origin.
